

Chiseldon Football Club Emergency Plan



Recreation Ground Address

Chiseldon Recreation Ground, Norris Close, Chiseldon, Swindon, Wiltshire, **SN4 0LP**.

To reach the Recreation Ground, travel to the end of Norris Close and turn right onto the single lane track. The car park is at 100 yards at the end of the track.



Recreation Ground Access

Access to the Recreation Ground field is via a padlocked gate within the carpark. Keys to the padlock are held by each manager of a Chiseldon FC team. In an event requiring access to the Recreation Ground field the relevant manager will have the key(s) about their person.

Nearest Defibrillator

A community defibrillator is available a short distance from the Recreation Ground located at the Memorial Hall on Draycott Road. The quickest route is to leave the Recreation Ground via the footpath near the senior football pitch (at the opposite end of the ground from the car park). At the bottom of the path, turn right towards the roundabout then take the right turn onto Draycott Road. The Memorial Hall is a large building on the right hand side approximately 50 meters from the roundabout.

Access to the defibrillator requires a code which can be obtained from the Emergency Services. **The person obtaining the device will need a phone** to liaise with the Emergency Services and obtain the code.



Emergency Aider / First Aid Kit

All managers of Chiseldon FC teams hold in-date Emergency Aid qualification. Unless otherwise informed, the relevant team manager is the appointed provider of Emergency Aid. A first aid kit will be present within the manager's technical area.
